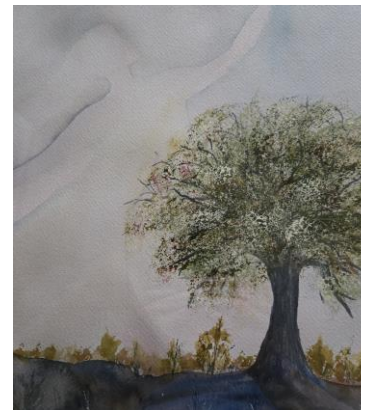
How Do We Cultivate the Deep Roots of Knowing God is Always With Us.
