The Residential Difference

- We serve *young* kids; age 4-14
- 243 referrals in the past year
- 40 referrals were ages 8 and under
- Average length of stay 18 months
- 81% are kids from Montana

According to our Youth Outcome Questionnaire, 100% of the kids who completed the Residential treatment program saw significant clinical improvement.
