

Camp Counselor Responsibilities
Westminster Spires Camp
Yellowstone Presbytery

The primary role of Camp Counselors at Westminster Spires is threefold:

- 1) Build relationships with campers.
- 2) Safety and well-being of campers
- 3) Spiritual formation of campers and self.

As a counselor, you will...

- Guide a cabin of 8-10 campers through daily camp life, ensuring safety and well being at all times.
- Share Jesus's love during small group reflection time following worship and teaching sessions, through facilitating reflective conversations and listening well.
- Build trusting relationships with campers and provide excellent supervise for campers in all activities
- Coordinate with Program Directors to lead recreation activities and team building exercises
- Actively participate in worship leadership, engaging with campers and using your unique gifts to provide leadership (music, testimonials, etc)
- Assist in leadership of small group free time activities (Crafts, hikes, special activities, skills)
- Provide leadership for cabin workgroups (kitchen, clean up, etc).
- Coordinate with Program Directors to facilitate snack time, campfire set-up and night games.
- Step in as a resource when a need arises (Other duties as discovered and assigned!)

As a member of Christian community, you will...

- Attend morning Staff Devotions
- Attend Staff Huddle
- Participate fully in worship and engage in exploration of your own faith in Jesus
- Develop relationships with other counselors, Program Directors, Camp Director, and volunteers
- Share burdens with Directors and seek support when needed

All Camp Counselors will be encouraged to attend "Limitless Camp" at no cost at the end of the summer. This is an opportunity to engage in camp fun, go on some adventures and build deeper relationships with others and with Jesus.
