Presbytery of Yellowstone Leadership Cabinet (LC) Meeting Minutes April 30, 2013 1st Church, Bozeman, Montana

Moderator Leon called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

- 1. **Opening Prayer** The opening prayer was offered by Curt Kochner.
- 2. Christ Candle Leon read the Litany of the Christ Candle and lit the Christ Candle.
- **3. Introduction** Suzanne introduced Merri Lee Hooks, the new Moderator of Presbyterian Women
- **4. Quorum** The Clerk declared that a Quorum was present.
- 5. **Docket** The docket was approved with the following additions: presbytery insurance coverage, Heidelberg Catechism and the approval of the Docket for the June presbytery meeting- not the February presbytery meeting.
- **6. Dwelling in the Word** George led this item. His selection of scripture was Jeremiah 32:1-15. Following the reading of portions by different members the group responded with what this selection meant to them. Following a series of prayers by those present George offered a closing prayer for this section.
- 7. **Structure Task Force Report** George started the report and passed around a sheet and talked to the contents of that sheet which traced the history of the effort. Dan presented the financial situation. "**We will be out funds on October 20, 2016**". Ric talked to some of the options, such as technology, that the VSTF has been looking into. He then talked to the make up of the LC. Ron presented the proposed responsibilities/ membership of the LC. A wide ranging discussion followed. George summarized the main concerns as follows 1). The make-up of the LC, 2). The Funds for the Covent Orders, 3).

- A unified budget and 4). Transitioning to a new structure.
- **8. Election** Dan Holland was elected to the B&F committee for the class of 2015 and as moderator of that group.
- **9. Lunch -** Don offered the blessing for our lunch.
- **10. Synod Consultation** Rev. Scott Wipperman Led a discussion on 8 questions posed by the Synod Coordinating Council as they are looking at the future role of the Synod.
- 11. **Election of the 2013-2014 Synod Commissioners.** Jim Tarr, Neva Rathbun, Jed Cauffman and Don Holland along with Ron Hanson as an alternate were elected.
- 12. **Miles City Grant request** The church has submitted a written request for a \$2,000 grant to purchase a new curriculum for Children's Education called "Godly Play". The Leadership Cabinet approved the request with the requirement that the program be reviewed by the church's insurance carrier.
- 13. **Adjustments to the Leadership Cabinet write-up -** Jim moved that membership be changed by adding up to three At-Large members. The Leadership Cabinet voted to approve this motion. Don raised a concern on how this will be presented to Presbytery.
- 14. **Board of Pensions** Jim presented a written report covering the Board of Pension's (BOP) Regional gathering in Dallas, Texas. The Major Medical (MM) portion of the plan increased by .75% for 2013. The BOP is looking at three options for the MM portion dues for 2014 and 2015.
- **15. Christus Collegium** George presented a draft Repurchase Agreement. It was voted to sign the Agreement subject to it being reviewed by our attorney. The Agreement calls for ten annual payments of \$2,000 to the presbytery.
- 16. **Docket** The Docket was extended for 15 minutes.
- 17. Committee Reports:
 - Co-General Presbyters George presented their written report.
 - Camping & Youth Curt presented a written report. He noted that a veteran Camp Staff will be available for the 2013 camps. He also noted that the 2013-2014 Prayer Chain will be finalized and sent out.
 - **Mission** Jim reported that the donations received for the Zimbabwe project were sold for a total of \$1,600. This money will be forwarded to Zimbabwe.
 - **COM** Neva had submitted a written report. She requested time on the presbytery Docket for the June meeting on Friday to grant Rev. Leon Rathbun Honorably Retired status and to present him with a gift. The Leadership Cabinet instructed Ron to place this item on the Docket.
 - **Vocations** Jim presented the committee's written report.
 - **HE** Bob presented a written report. The main item was the planning for a series of gatherings to start the implementation of a state-wide UKirk program.
 - **PW** Merri Lee presented a written report PW held its business meeting at the Spring Gathering on April 13-14, 2013. She offered to tell her story, at the presbytery meeting, of the death of her son-in-law, as a result of a drive by shooting. It was decided that her story might be best told at a workshop at the Convocation.
 - **Nominations** Ted reported that a letter will be sent out asking for nominations for Ruling Elder and YAAD Commissioners to the 2014 General Assembly.
 - Ordination Exam Readers The Leadership Cabinet elected Jim Tarr and Susan Thomas to be readers from Yellowstone Presbytery.

- 18. **Heidelberg Catechism** The Leadership Cabinet suggested Jody or Kathy present this proposed amendment, for a vote, at the presbytery meeting. Ron will contact them.
- 19. **Docket Extension** The Docket was extended for 15 minutes.
- 20. **Presbytery Meeting Docket** Ron passed out a draft for the June meeting of presbytery. Following some discussion it was decided to have Ron finalize the Docket.
- 21. **Adjournment** The meeting was adjourned at 3:20 p.m. George offered a closing prayer.
