- a. The Synod Exec, Zane Buxton, has resigned; The Synod Office manager, Rebecca Kennedy has resigned.
  - a. Synod Council is the governing body.
  - b. Lines of authority need clearer definition.
  - c. Immediate Goals and purposes for the Synod need definition.
  - d. The GA Commission to Study Middle Governing Bodies is now functioning.

## What the Synod Does for us:

- a. Staff Resources.
  - a. Stated Clerk answers polity questions for presbyteries.
  - b. Synod Exec:
    - i. has helped with thorny CoM issues.
    - ii. has visited and related connectively at presbytery meetings.
    - iii. Has informed and interpreted the actions of the GA and represented our interests to the larger church.
  - c. Synod Execs have resourced our CoM with training and I have resourced them.
- b. WNLT Leadership Training. Bringing quality (most of the time) training to the Synod region.
  - a. Collegial Learning and teaching.
- c. Partnership funds... through the Synod to us from GA and Denver Presbytery.
  - a. 2004 \$75,000; 2010 \$48,600
- d. Loans and Grant support.
  - a. Synod can make loans to presbyteries and ministries, i.e. camps.
  - b. Supports requests for grants from GA funds.
- e. Mission Partnerships Zimbabwe with Denver Presbytery
- f. Sharing of expenses and events for GA staff and others who visit and inform.
- g. Other....
