Ray Vandel__-mimic, follow attached, chosen by the Master. A call to follow

Invitation to a Journey- God does disciple

Learner, student of our yielding to Christ

Mark: to be w/ Christ, that he =might send out –[this is a continuous Rhythm]

[Disciple] Acts, [does]signs, demonstrate

How for love of Christ, Do this today in our context & cultures

Mark: Christ-likeness, & John 13:34,35 I choose you to love...all
