Have Scripture, Will Worship

The goal of this workshop is to give you resources for preparing a worship service.

PRAY before, during, and after. You will be amazed at the connections the Holy Spirit will make as you write, and then participate in, worship.

On-line worship is best when it is 30-40 minutes long.

Expect to give at least an hour or two in preparing the service. Consider the time and energy you spend on preparing a worship service to be part of your Devotional Life. You are soaking yourself in Holy Scripture. And that's a good thing!

Have Scripture, Will Worship

Prayer of Confession - Look for verses that say what NOT to do, or need to be corrected in our lives and then close with a verse that asks God/Jesus/Spirit to help us.

The following is from Philippians 2:3-4, 14

Almighty God/Loving Father/God of all compassion

"Forgive us for our selfish ambitions and conceit."

"Forgive us for regarding ourselves as better than others."

"Forgive us for the times we murmur and argue."

"Give us the same mind that was in Christ Jesus"; in whose name we pray. Amen.

Affirmation of Faith - Look for scripture that says something about God/Jesus/Holy Spirit. Philippians 2:5-11 - Ancient hymn to Christ

Dedication - Scripture that calls us to DO something

The following are suggestions from Philippians 2:5, 12, 15, 16"

"We dedicate our lives to having the same mind that was in Christ Jesus."

"We will work out our own salvation with fear and trembling."

"We dedicate ourselves to shining like stars in the world."

"We promise to hold fast to the Word of life."
