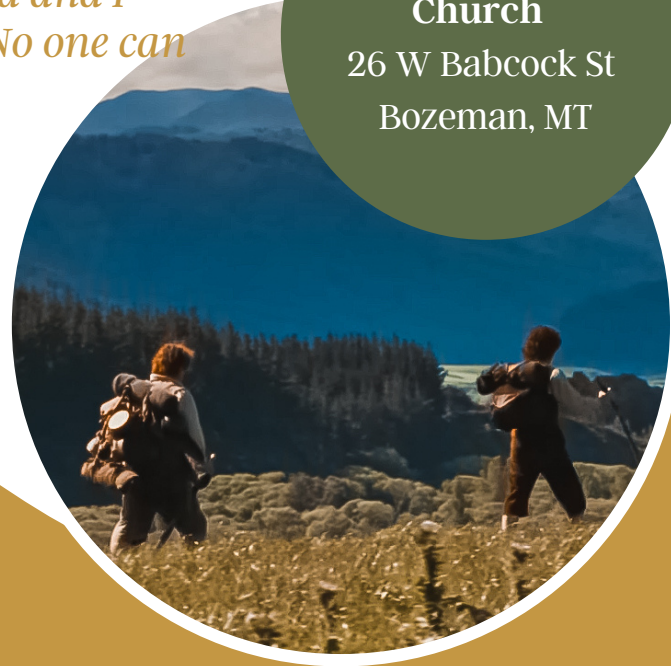
Dr. Ron Pyle
