

The Mission Committee Report – March 2 and 3, 2012 have some great opportunities ahead of us...

Key Issues and Tasks before this Our Mission Team as they:

Setting the Goals and orienting the committee for 2012.

- a. Running the Meetings on an agenda of the presbytery vision statement / discipleship and specific tasks to accomplish, including dwelling in the word.
- b. Rewrite the Standing Rules for this committee in light of NFoG with the guidance of the NFoG task force and the Vision statement of the presbytery.
- c. Funds to promote mission by the presbytery and its congregations have increased.
 - i. Develop a plan to disperse these funds according to any current stipulations.
- d. Assess and recommit to the Zimbabwe mission program with Denver Presbytery.
 - i. Determine some better means for getting mission offerings to Zimbabwe.
- e. Promote Mission by and between local congregations:
 - i. Develop a network of those interested in mission in the presbytery.
 - ii. Congregational mission trips.
 - iii. Helping congregations launch mission in their own communities, especially in partnerships.
- f. Promote WNLT and disperse scholarships for the conference, October 3-5, 2012 in Jackson Hole, WY.
- g. Possible emerging mission: Partner with certain congregations to explore mission among the Native Americans in Montana. There is a new initiative in Glacier emerging along these lines, too.
- h. OTHER...? The Committee wants to work with and promote missions where they are happening – does your church have a mission story to share with the presbytery? Please share it with us. Whether: local, regional, national or international – or church-wide, cluster, youth, etc. based.
